

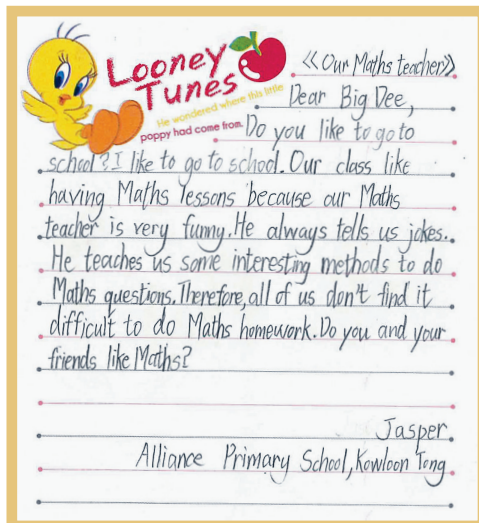
Our maths teacher

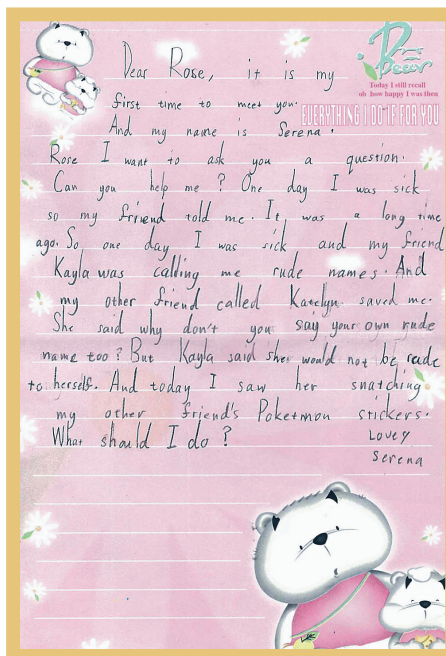


Problems with friends
