■ E.g. I am a nurse.





□ Plural: We

- E.g. We are having dinner.
- 2nd Person
 - □ Singular / Plural: You
 - E.g. You are a doctor / doctors.
- 3rd Person
 - □ Singular: He / She / It
 - E.g. He doesn't like running.
 - E.g. She asked a good question.
 - E.g. It looks like monkey.
 - □ Plural: They
 - E.g. They are making up the story.

- 1st Person
 - □ Singular: Me
 - E.g. Please tell me the truth.
 - □ Plural: Us
 - E.g. Don't look at us.
- 2^{nd} Person
 - □ Singular / Plural: You
 - E.g. I love playing with you.
- 3rd Person



- □ Singular: Him / Her / It
 - E.g. Give him some food.
 - E.g. You can ask her for help.
 - E.g. Who is it?
- □ Plural: Them
 - E.g. Don't tell them the secret.

- 1st Person
 - □ Singular: My
 - E.g. My name is Mary.
 - □ Plural: Our
 - E.g. Our goal is to get an A.

• 2^{nd} Person

- □ Singular / Plural: Your
 - E.g. May I borrow your pen?

■ 3rd Person

- □ Singular: His / Her / Its
 - E.g. His clothes is worn-out.
 - E.g. Her dog is sick.
 - E.g. Its toy is missing.
- □ Plural: Their
 - E.g. The girls have tried their best to complete the task.

- 1st Person
 - □ Singular: Mine
 - E.g. This is not my bag; mine is white.
 - □ Plural: Ours
 - E.g. Their dolls are very similar to ours.
- 2nd Person
 - □ Singular / Plural: Yours
 - E.g. Is that apple yours?
- 3rd Person
 - □ Singular: His / Hers / Its
 - E.g. My room is bigger than his / hers / its.
 - □ Plural: Theirs
 - E.g. It's a favourite toy of theirs.

5. Reflexive Pronouns 反射代名詞

■ 1st Person

□ Singular: Myself





- E.g. I myself can make it.
- □ Plural: Ourselves
 - E.g. We enjoy ourselves.
- 2nd Person
 - □ Singular: Yourself
 - E.g. Please help yourself to some meat.
 - □ Plural: Yourselves
 - E.g. Believe in yourselves!
- 3rd Person
 - □ Singular: Himself / Herself / Itself
 - E.g. He / She will be himself / herself again soon.
 - E.g. The thing itself goes wrong.
 - □ Plural: Themselves
 - E.g. The boys are arguing among themselves.
