■ "a" is used before words starting in consonant sounds and "an" is used before words starting with vowel sounds (corresponding letters: A E I O U, but pay attention to the highlighted words below)

### **□** Examples:

- a woman, a student, a flower, a cat, a university, a union, a European country
- an apple, an eraser, an ant, an envelope, an old lady, an English book, an hour, an umbrella, an honest girl

## **□** Sample sentences:

- E.g. I gave Peter an eraser as a gift.
- E.g. We have **an oral exam** every Monday morning.

### 3. Definite article: the

■ Definite article 定冠詞: the		
☐ To describe specific person (or people) or thing (or things).		
☐ It can be used before a countable or uncountable noun.		
□ Rules:		
■ (1) Use "the" when the noun names the only one (or one) of a kind.		
■ Examples: the sun, the world, the moon, the sky, the sea, the best student		
■ (2) Use "the" when the noun is related to <b>national disciplined services</b> .		
■ Examples: the police, the army, the air force, the navy		
■ (3) Use "the" when you describe <b>specific location</b> .		
■ Examples: the top, the bottom, the left, the right, the middle, the end		
■ (4) Use "the" before the <b>musical instrument</b> .		
■ Examples: the piano, the violin, the cello, the flute, the drum, the guitar, t		
clarinet		

**□** Sample sentences:





- E.g. **The tree** over there is very old.
- E.g. I believe you are **the best student** in your class.

■ Zero article 零冠詞			
☐ A noun is not proceeded by an article (i.e., a, an, or the).			
□ Rules:			
■ (1) when talking in general about plural or uncountable nouns			
☐ E.g. Life is so hard for <b>retailers</b> under the outbreak of the coronavirus.			
■ (2) when referring to proper nouns			
■ E.g. I will go	o to University of Cambridge in autumn.		
☐ E.g. Nation	al Gallery will be closed at noon.		
■ (3) when referring t	o certain times		

■ E.g. Ghosts show up at **night**.

■ E.g. I will meet my instructor **tomorrow**.





- (4) when referring to meals and sports
  - E.g. I have breakfast in canteen every day.
  - ☐ E.g. I love playing basketball / chess / table tennis.
